

Bathroom Cleaner is a water based light blue liquid. For cleaning toilet bowls, vanities, showers, baths, floor tiles, porcelain and other surfaces in a bathroom.

USE DIRECTIONS

Apply Spray Solution to soiled surfaces. Allow a few seconds for the solution to chemically soften soils. For stubborn soils, use a brush or pad to loosen. Rinse with clean water.

PREPARING BATHROOM **SPRAY CLEANER**

- 1. Fill a 750ml Spray Bottle to the base of the neck with water.
- 2. Add TWO pumps of Bathroom Cleaner Concentrate to the Bottle
- 3. Screw on trigger, and invert spray bottle twice to mix
